### **Med Fest – a free general checkup clinic**

“Health is Wealth”.....

Well, our wealth is our Athletes and that's why we think it is our prime duty to see whether our athletes are physically fit or not.

Special Olympics Gujarat always takes care for their athletes.

Recently on 14<sup>th</sup> Aug 07 to 17<sup>th</sup> Aug 07 Special Olympics Gujarat organized Med fest program along with district tournament.

Special Olympics Gujarat – Surat had organized Torch Run and opening ceremony on 14<sup>th</sup> Aug. 2007. At 02:00 pm torch run were started from Kargil Chaowk, Surat and it arrived on M.T. B collage ground, Athwalines, Surat at 5:00 pm. In opening ceremony, Mr. Troy Greisen, managing director, Special Olympics Asia Pacific, Mayor, Surat District, and Managing Director, Larsen and Toubro Ltd, were our chief guest. More than 1000 people were there in opening ceremony.

Total 528 intellectual disabled persons were registered in med fest program. About 15 doctors, 25 Clinical Volunteers and 10 non clinical volunteers had worked voluntarily. 25 clinical volunteers were from JSM Nursing College, Surat.

Main sponsorship for Med fest was given from Larsen and Toubro Ltd., Hazira Works. And our other supported sponsors were Rotary Club Surat Sea Face, Sumul – Taste and Purity Together, Essar – A Positive Attitude, Garden Silk Mill and Lakshmi dimonds.

As per evaluation form, first day 227 persons were screened, second day 175 and third day 126 persons were screened in Med fest. Out of these, 166 athletes referred for further treatment and 362 athletes were medically cleared.

We made check up stations for Med fest. Every person was going through that proper channel and we put one volunteer for one person who was taking that person to all stations.

Executive Summary

“Health is Wealth” .....

Well, our wealth is our Athletes and that's why we think it is our prime duty to see whether our athletes are physically fit or not. And the Healthy Athletes screenings are an important part of the all Games experience for athletes, who often do not receive regular or adequate health care.

Special Olympics Gujarat always takes care for their athletes. Recently on 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> Dec 07, Special Olympics Gujarat organized Opening Eye, FUNfitness and Health Promotion along with district tournament.

Total 595 intellectual disabled persons were registered in Healthy Athlete program. About 11 doctors, 62 Clinical Volunteers and 40 non clinical volunteers had worked in this event. Out of these volunteers 24volunteers



were from Nagar School of optometry, 35 volunteers were from, and remaining 10 non clinical volunteers were from Balaji collage.

Main sponsorship for Healthy Athlete Program was given from IPCL (Reliance) who had sponsored ground. And our other supported sponsors were Special Olympics Gujarat, GACL and Bank of Baroda.

As per evaluation form, in FUNfitness total 447 athletes were screened, out of that 50 athletes referred for further treatment. In Health Promotion total 541 athletes were screened and all were medically cleared. Same as in Opening Eyes total 509 athletes were screened out of that 134 athletes were received prescription eyewear and remaining 375 athletes got sports goggles.

We made check up stations for Healthy Athlete Program. Every person was going through that proper channel and we put one volunteer for one person who was taking that person to all stations.
